Kids can participate in games and a reading of Dr. Seuss' "The Lorax". The event, including raffle prizes and a beer garden, takes place on the lawn of the Bit & Spur Restaurant at 1212 Zion Park Boulevard from 12:00 Noon to 6:00 P.M. You may join a guided wildflower walk at 9:00 A.M. on the day of the event by meeting at the shuttle bus stop in front of the Bit & Spur Restaurant.
